Tuesday: Math: Rainbow Fish math

Wednesday: Social Studies: Talk to a family member or friend about why being a good citizen is important? What makes someone a good citizen?

Kg and 1st graders: Draw a picture of you or someone you know doing something that makes them a good citizen (helping others, picking up trash, etc.)

2nd – 5th graders: Make a list of qualities that make someone a good citizen. On the back, draw a picture of you doing something to be a good citizen.

Thursday: Science: Using a piece of cardboard (from any type of box), have an adult cut out a fish shape. Fill a bowl with water and place the fish in the bowl.

1. Ask yourself: What do you think will happen to the fish? Why?
2. Add a drop of soap behind the fish's tail and watch what happens. Draw a picture of what you see.
